It occurs to me that I should give you a thumb nail sketch of some of my own activities related to minority issues this year.

a-- Joyce Corbin came to me at the beginning of the school year and asked me to be the moderator of a student club, the African-American Society. I agreed to do that with the understanding that we would seek a person of color to replace me as soon as they found one. To date they have not come up with any one and appear to appreciate my efforts on their behalf. The club budget as with all clubs is \$100. They have used that for their own activities mostly food at the first meeting in International House. I have been at several meetings, all but 2. There are less than 20 members of all races. The club has sponsored a film series and commentary by faculty persons.

b-- In support of the group and also Black History month I have gotten the Lecture Series to sponsor JUAN WILLIAMS as a nationally black speaker 2/28/90. This is being jointly sponsored by the Af Am Society, Student Affairs and the Lec
